	Note: God demands Israel's as well as their obedience! Proverbs 3:5-7; Psalm 19:7; Isaiah 40:28-31 -

	Note: Circumcision was an outward/physical of God's covenant with Abraham. <i>Genesis 17:11 -</i>					
	Note: Circumcision was a mark of separation NEVER a means of!!! Hebrews 3:16-19 -

II. Our Redemption Is Remembered (verses 10-12)

Exodus 13:3 - "Remember this day in which you came out from Egypt, out of the house of slavery, for by a strong hand the Lord brought you out from this place."
Note: The Israelites were about to go into battle and they needed to their deliverance
Note: The Old Testament records ONLY occasions when Israel celebrated the Passover!
1 Corinthians 11:23-26 -
2) The NOURISHMENT after the Passover!
Why did God stop giving them manna??? Why did He stop providing for them???
Note: God's provision is not often miraculous and so it often goes unseen &
III. Our Rescuer Is Reverenced (verses 13-15)
1) Jesus: The Divine Captain with the Sword
So WHO is this Man with the drawn sword???
Note: If Joshua does indeed reverence/worship this "Person" then this must be!
Jude 14; 2 Thessalonians 1:7b-8; Psalm 24:7-10; Exodus 15:3; Exodus 14:14 -
2) Joshua: The Dedicated Leader with the Question
Note: The answer that Joshua gets from the Commander is a total game!
Note: God's not going to align with us & submit to us; we must align with & submit to!
1 John 5:4-5 - "For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world - our faith. Who is it that overcomes the world except the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?"
