## JOHN 6:1 - 15 - "HEAVENLY BREAD & HARD HEARTS"

### Introduction

*John 5:13 - "Now the man who had been healed did not know who it was, for Jesus had withdrawn, as there was a crowd in the place."*

### C. The Complainers, Philip & Andrew: Disciples Filled with \_\_\_\_\_ & Despondency

**Exodus 14:13-14** - *“Fear not, stand firm, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will work for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall never see again. The Lord will fight for you, and you have only to be silent.”*

**Psalm 20:7** - *“Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the Lord our God.”*

**Hebrews 4:16** - *“Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.”*
