Colossians 1:16 - "all things were created through Him and for Him."	
Note: See all things in relationship to and you will see them as they truly are.	
5) There has never been created that wasn't created by Jesus.	
6) Jesus, as "the Word", is the perfect, the ultimate, and revelation of	God.
Why didn't John write, "In the beginning was the Action or Emotion/Passion or Thought"?

John 14:9 - "Whoever has seen Me has seen the Father."
