RESTORATION IS FOUND IN CHRIST John 21:15-19

A group of men join Jesus on the shores of the Sea of Tiberias. This is now the third time that Jesus met with the disciples after His resurrection.

I-Jesus asked a question to be answered by all- John 21:15

A-Jesus asks a question to get at <u>Peter's love</u> for his Lord-1-What did 'more than these' really mean? 2-Do you love me more than these <u>other men</u> do?
B-Jesus reminded Peter of what he had said in the <u>Upper Room</u>.
C-Jesus called Peter ' Simon son of John' the first time that they met. 1-Jesus was taking Peter back to the time he was <u>called</u>. 2-He was not just reminding him of his denials.
D-There are times when we need to think back to when God first <u>called us</u>.

II-Jesus knows the answers to all questions in our hearts- 21:17

A-Jesus knows <u>our hearts</u>, even when we question ourselves.
B-Jesus was taking Peter back to that day when he <u>committed himself</u> to the Savor.
C-Jesus asked Peter, 'Do you love me?'

1-Jesus wasn't questioning this man.
2-Jesus was helping him place his trust where it belonged, in <u>his Savior</u>.

D-Jesus called Peter to care for <u>the flock</u>.

III-Jesus knows our past and our futures- 21:18

A-Jesus told Peter what would happen in <u>his future</u>.Peter would become a martyr.B-Jesus showed Peter that he would <u>GLORIFY GOD</u>.

Paul says, 'You are not your own, For you are bought with a price. Therefore, glorify God in your body.' 1 Cor.6:19-20
