

God's Glorious Church in Real Life Sermon Title: "A 'Foolish' Message & The Power of God"- Part 2 of 2 Scripture: 1 Corinthians 1:18-30 Pastor Stephen Schultze / Sunday, September 27, 2020

## Introduction:

A strong dose of redemption reality is an effective remedy for divisive feelings of superiority within the church.

- 1. The church is unified when we remember our calling from hopelessness. (v. 26) Scripture: Luke 18:25; Zephaniah 3:12; Colossians 3:15
  - When we remember who we each were before Christ, it is hard to ignore who we are together in Christ.
- God's gracious salvation wrecks our worldly standards for significance. (v. 27-29)
  Scripture: James 1:9-10; Psalms 37:10-11; Isaiah 2:11
  - The despised and rejected of the world make glorious trophies of God's sovereign grace. (Ephesians 2:7-9)
- 3. Our blessings in Christ initiate a glorious symphony of worship to God. (v. 30-31) Scripture: Ephesians 1:3-6, 12, 14; Galatians 6:14; 2 Corinthians 4:7

"When we are in Christ, every part of Christ's life, not only his death, has significance for us...All that is his becomes ours." (Rankin Wilbourne)

• The more fully we comprehend the depths of our sin and the heights of God's grace, the more confidently we will sing His praise. (*Revelation 5:9-13*)

Instructions for unity: Remember. Repent. Rejoice. Repeat.
