## Introduction:

A strong dose of redemption reality is an effective remedy for divisive feelings of superiority within the church.

1. The church is unified when we remember our calling from hopelessness. (v. 26)

Scripture: Luke 18:25; Zephaniah 3:12; Colossians 3:15

- When we remember who we each were before Christ, it is hard to ignore who we are together in Christ.

2. God's gracious salvation wrecks our worldly standards for significance. (v. 27-29)

Scripture: James 1:9-10; Psalms 37:10-11; Isaiah 2:11

- The despised and rejected of the world make glorious trophies of God's sovereign grace. (Ephesians 2:7-9)

3. Our blessings in Christ initiate a glorious symphony of worship to God. (v. 30-31)

Scripture: Ephesians 1:3-6, 12, 14; Galatians 6:14; 2 Corinthians 4:7
"When we are in Christ, every part of Christ's life, not only his death, has significance for us...All that is his becomes ours." (Rankin Wilbourne)

- The more fully we comprehend the depths of our sin and the heights of God's grace, the more confidently we will sing His praise. (Revelation 5:9-13)

Instructions for unity: Remember. Repent. Rejoice. Repeat.
