

Sermon Title: "Stewardship of Treasure" Scripture: Matthew 6:19-24 Pastor Stephen Schultze Sunday, January 24, 2021

Introduction:

Kingdom economics are a practical application of the Lord's Prayer, "your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven" (*Matthew 6:10*).

- **1.** The location of your treasure is a true measure of your spiritual health. (v. 19-21) Scripture: Jeremiah 17:9; Proverbs 4:23
 - The stewardship of treasure begins with vigilant care of your heart. (*James 1:14*)
 - The deceitfulness of riches is a deadly threat to your heart. (*Matthew 13:22; 19:23*)
- **2.** Focusing on earthly treasure blurs your eternal vision. (v. 22-23)
 - Spiritual vision enables you to see and pursue God's purposes and plans.

Scripture: Psalm 119:105; Romans 12:2; Luke 12:18-21

3. What (or who) you serve commands your will. (v. 24)

"The person with the misplaced **HEART** (v. 21) and misdirected **MIND** (v. 22-23) also suffers from a misaligned **WILL** (v. 24)." *William Hendriksen*

Scripture: 1 John 2:15-17; Romans 8:13-14

• If you do not serve God alone, you do not serve God at all.

Conclusion:

The person who invests in God's Kingdom on earth will receive glorious dividends in heaven. Scripture: *1 Timothy 6:17-19*
