Point 1

Once we are washed, though sin remains, we are no longer defined by it.

Point 2

Once we are washed, we are free to pursue that which <u>benefits</u> us, instead of that which <u>destroys</u> us.

Point 3

God designed our bodies and its desires with an eternal purpose in mind.

Point 4

Since the whole of who we are belongs to <u>Christ</u>, He alone <u>defines</u> who we are and how we live.

Questions to Consider:

With regards to sexual immorality, where are the areas you need to flee?

Since fleeing is an action we are called to continuously make, what specific actions will you take today to flee areas of sexual immorality in your own life?

Where is one area you are allowing the voice of the culture to influence your life more than God's voice?

What is the fruit that is resulting from listening to the culture in that particular area?

Spend some time asking God to allow His Spirit to convict you of sin you may not see. Ask Him to equip you with all that is needed to flee from your sin and run towards Him.
