I. Putting to death the idols of our heart require <u>continuous action</u>.

(Vss 14-15; Ps 139:23-24; Col 3:5; Rom 6; Eph 5; Col 3)

II. Idols <u>play in the gray</u> and <u>lure us away</u> from where God is and wants us to be.

(Vss 16-20; Lev 7)

III. If we embrace what God abhors, we stand to face the <u>loving correction</u> of a <u>jealous God</u>.

(Vss 19-22; Rev 3:14-22; Matt 24 & 25; Heb 12)

IV. Our history of and personal propensity towards idolatry, means we can <u>never assume</u> it's <u>absence</u>.

(1 Cor 10:12, Phil 2:12-13)

Take some time today, and throughout this week, to seek the face of God and ask His Spirit to reveal areas where idolatry exists in your own heart.

Meditate on the words of David's prayer in Psalm 139:23-24 to help guide your prayer time. As the Holy Spirit reveals, confess and repent of them by name.
