

Sermon Title: The Lord's Supper, Part 1

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 11:17-34

1. Blatant disregard for the Lord's supper or the Lord's church deserves a sobering rebuke. (v. 17a)

Scripture: Galatians 5:9

2. The church is the assembly of genuine believers which gathers for the mutual good and the glory of God. (v. 17b)

Scripture: Ephesians 1:22-23

- 3. Ungodly practices can be as divisive and revealing as false teaching. (v. 18-19) Scripture: James 3:13-14
- **4. What is done in Christ's name must reflect Christ's heart and purpose.** (v. 20-22) **Scripture:** Colossians 1:18; Galatians 5:22-23
- 5. The Lord's Supper is a regular reminder of our common union in Christ. (v. 23-25)
 Scripture: 1 John 4:11-12

Each gathering of the church ought to heighten our love for God and His church.

Questions to Consider:

- 1. What practices or attitudes are potentially divisive within the church? What might our practices reveal about one's heart?
- 2. What are some ways in which our regular gathering promotes the glory of God and the mutual good of His church?
- 3. In what ways are we tempted to disregard one another in the church?
- 4. If Christ is head of the church, preeminent over all things, how ought that be reflected in the practices of the local church?
- 5. How does the proper practice of the Lord's Supper promote our love for Christ and fellow believers?
