

Sermon Title: "The Way of the Spirit" Scripture: 1 Corinthians 13:1-3 Pastor Stephen Schultze / Sunday, July 18, 2021

God has given every believer gifts through the Holy Spirit to be a <mark>contributing</mark> member of the Body of Christ.

- The way of the Spirit is love, not performance. (1 Corinthians 12:31)
- **1.** Without Love, the most eloquent communication is empty noise. (v. 1) Scripture: Ephesians 4:15-16; Matthew 12:33-37; Ephesians 4:29-30
 - The body of Christ should be a concert of grace—each member using their gifts to communicate love in harmony with the Holy Spirit. (*Proverbs 25:11*)
- 2. Without Love, the power to know great things and do mighty acts is nothing. (v. 2) Scripture: Matthew 7:21-23; Mark 12:29-31
 - The gifts of the Spirit are given to build God's glorious church, not our kingdom.
- 3. Without Love, the most zealous acts are empty of reward. (v. 3) *Scripture: Galatians 5:22-24*
 - Employing the gifts of the Spirit without love is spiritual mutiny.

Conclusion:

- Abide in Christ, the source of love. (John 15:5)
- Submit to the Spirit, the way of love. (Galatians 5:25)
- Serve in selflessness, the practice of love. (Galatians 5:13)
