What love is, love does. God is Love. Therefore, God's nature is displayed in what love does. Scripture: 1 John 4:18; Colossians 3:12-14

Love displays the mercy of God.

- Love is patient. (1 Peter 4:8; Ephesians 4:2; 1 Thessalonians 5:14)
- Love is kind. (1 John 3:16-18; Ephesians 4:32a; Luke 6:35-36)

Love displays the humility of Christ.

- Love does not envy. (1 Corinthians 3:3; Romans 1:29)
- Love does not boast. (Proverbs 13:10; Romans 1:30)
- Love is not arrogant. (Proverbs 26:12; Romans 12:16)
- Love is not rude. (Romans 12:10; Philippians 2:3)
- Love is not self-promoting. (Romans 15:1-3)
- Love is not irritable. (*Proverbs* 12:16; 14:17; 15:18)
- Love is not resentful (bitter). (Hebrews 12:15)

Conclusion: (1 John 4:9-12, 15-16)

- Know and believe Christ's love.
- Meditate on Christ's love.
- Walk in the way of Christ's love.
