The 5 Solas:

8/15: *Solus Christus* ("Christ alone" or "through Christ alone")

8/22: *Sola scriptura* ("by Scripture alone")

8:29: *Soli Deo gloria* (to the "glory to God alone")

9/5: *Sola fide* ("by faith alone") and *Sola gratia* ("by grace alone")

Scripture: Romans 5:10, 19

4. **Christ alone because His work is _____ and _____. (Rev. 5:8-10)**

Scripture: Hebrews 9:12; Galatians 2:21; 5:2-4; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Acts 4:12; John 14:6

5. **Christ alone because anything else _____ God of His glory! (Rev. 5:11-14)**

Scripture: Isaiah 42:5-8; Matthew 11:28-29
