Scripture: 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

Introduction: In 1 Corinthians 15, Paul addresses 4 basic questions about the resurrection:

- 1. Are the dead raised? (v. 12)
- 2. When are the dead raised? (v. 23)
- 3. How are the dead raised? (v. 35)
- 4. Why are the dead raised? (v. 50)

V. 1-11: The Priority of Christ's Resurrection:

- 1-2: The believer's salvation gives evidence of the resurrection.
 - Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 1:21; Ephesians 2:8-9; James 2:26; John 6:37; Romans 5:10
- 3-4: The Scriptures and Apostles consistently proclaimed the resurrection.
 - Scriptures: Galatians 1:18-19; 2:1; Acts 2:24-36; Hosea 6:2; Jonah 1:17; Matthew 12:40; Isa. 53:10-12

5-8: The resurrected Lord was witnessed by many people at various times.

Scriptures: Luke 24:34; Acts 9:3-6

9-11: God's transforming grace is confirmation of the resurrection.

• Scriptures: 2 Corinthians 5:14-15; Titus 2:11-13

Conclusion: The reality of the resurrection provides believers transforming power for today and a living hope for eternity! (Colossians 3:3-4; 1 Peter 1:3-5)
