I. VERSES 12-19: IMAGINE IF THERE IS NO RESURRECTION
1 Corinthians 15:12-13 -
1) Jesus was a man. Jesus died. If there is no resurrection, then you have a savior.
Hebrews 2:17; Acts 2:22; 1 Timothy 2:5; 1 Corinthians 15:21 -
1 Corinthians 15:14-15 -
2) Gospel preaching, which calls people to trust in Jesus, is a worthless if Jesus is dead.
Acts 2:24; Acts 4:10; Acts 17:31 -
1 Corinthians 15:16-17 -
3) If Jesus is still dead, then there is no forgiveness of sins, no justification, no
Romans 4:24-25; Romans 5:10 -
1 Corinthians 15:18 -
4) If Jesus is dead, then you and all your friends, family, and relatives will Him as in the grave.
1 Corinthians 15:19 -
5) If our resurrection hope is false and dies when we do, then we really are a, pitiable lot.
John 16:33; 2 Corinthians 11:23-28 -

Jude 24-25 -Note: By calling Jesus the "first-fruits", this means He was the first and that there's to come! Philippians 3:20-21 -1 Corinthians 15:21-22 -Note: Through Adam there is death; through Christ there is glorious, eternal ! Psalm 90:10 -Note: Because of Jesus, resurrection and eternal life (not death!) is the _____ of God's people! Romans 3:23-25 -1 Corinthians 15:23 -Note: There is _____ and purpose to God's sovereign plan for resurrection!
