

## Sermon Title: "Resurrection Clarity" Scripture: 1 Corinthians 15:35-49 Pastor Stephen Schultze / Sunday, November 7, 2021

Introduction: (v. 35-36)
The person rejects the resurrection, because in their heart they question God, His Word and the testimony of His creation. (Psalm 14:1; Job 19:26; 33:29-30)
The resurrection illustrated in creation: (v. 36b-41)
The seed that goes in the ground ultimately becomes something  Scripture: v. 36-37; John 12:23–24
Every seed produces what God has it to produce.  Scripture: v. 38-41; Genesis 1:11-12
The resurrection body described: (v. 42-49)
The glorified body is, yet gloriously transformed from the natural body.  Scripture: v. 42-44; Philippians 3:21
The last Adam gives to the powerless physical bodies of the dead in Christ.  Scripture: v. 45-46; Genesis 2:7)
The resurrected body of those in Christ will bear the of the heavenly prototype.  Scripture: v. 47-49; Colossians 1:18; Romans 8:29; 1 John 3:2; 2 John 7
