1. Craving approval is an insatiable earthly appetite.

Scriptures: John 5:39-44; Philippians 3:18-19; Romans 8:5-8; Ephesians 2:8-9; 2 Timothy 2:4:

2. Craving approval is rooted in misplaced hope.

Scriptures: Proverbs 13:20; Proverbs 3:5-6; Romans 12:2

3. Craving approval leads to ruin.

Scriptures: Luke 6:26; Matthew 6:1; Romans 2:6-8; Proverbs 18:24

4. Craving approval will stifle your Gospel witness.

Scriptures: 1 Thessalonians 2:3-6; Galatians 1:10
