Scripture Title: 2 Peter 1:12-15

## INTRODUCTION

2 Peter 1:12-15 and 2 Peter 3:1

Note: God is fully aware of our propensity to forget, and so His Word forever <u>stands</u> as a beacon of light, calling us to remember, calling us to "build our lives" on what is most important!

Joshua 4:6b-7 and Deuteronomy 6:6-7

Note: Verses 12-15 don't contain any direct commands to us, but that doesn't mean that we can be passive in response to this passage. There are MANY POINTS of <u>application</u> that subtly and not-so-subtly arise from this text!

- I. PARTICULAR PASSION... CONFIDENT POSSESSION... HOPEFUL URGENCY...
- 1) PARTICULAR PASSION: Waste no time recalling your position and privileges in Christ!

"Therefore I intend always to remind you of these qualities..." (2 Peter 1:12a)

**Immediate Point of Application:** You should <u>memorize</u> 2 Peter 1:3-11.

Note: Verses 3-4 REMIND us of Jesus' sufficiency and our complete standing in Him!

Note: Verses 5-7 CHALLENGE us to grow, to continually <u>supplement</u> our faith!

Note: Verses 8-11 ENCOURAGE and REFRESH our souls for the journey ahead!

## 2) CONFIDENT POSSESSION: God's people are <u>already</u> established in the truth!

"Therefore I intend always to remind you of these qualities, THOUGH YOU KNOW THEM and ARE ESTABLISHED in the TRUTH that you have." (2 Peter 1:12)

"...THE FAITH that was once for all delivered to the saints." (Jude 3b)

## 3) HOPE-FILLED URGENCY: Life is brief and glory is coming!

"I think it right, as long as I am in this body, to stir you up by way of reminder, since I know that the <u>putting off of my body will be soon</u>, as our Lord Jesus Christ made clear to me. And I will make every effort so that <u>after my departure</u> you may be able at any time to recall these things." (2 Peter 1:13-15)

Note: Peter describes his body as a disposable <u>tent</u>, and the word Peter uses translated as "departure" is the word "<u>exodus</u>".

"For we know that if THE TENT that is our earthly home is destroyed, we have A BUILDING from God, A HOUSE not made with hands, <u>eternal in the heavens</u>. For <u>in THIS TENT</u> we groan, <u>longing to put on our heavenly dwelling</u>..." (2 Corinthians 5:1-2)
