## **INTRODUCTION**

2 Peter 1:12-15 and 2 Peter 3:1
Note: God is fully aware of our propensity to forget, and so His Word forever as a beacon of light, calling us to remember, calling us to "build our lives" on what is most important!
Joshua 4:6b-7 and Deuteronomy 6:6-7
Note: Verses 12-15 don't contain any direct commands to us, but that doesn't mean that we can be passive in response to this passage. There are MANY POINTS ofthat subtly and not-so-subtly arise from this text!
I. PARTICULAR PASSION CONFIDENT POSSESSION HOPEFUL URGENCY
1) PARTICULAR PASSION: Waste no time your position and privileges in Christ!
"Therefore I intend always to remind you of these qualities" (2 Peter 1:12a)
Immediate Point of Application: You should 2 Peter 1:3-11.
Note: Verses 3-4 REMIND us of Jesus' sufficiency and our standing in Him!
Note: Verses 5-7 CHALLENGE us to grow, to continually our faith!
Note: Verses 8-11 ENCOURAGE and REFRESH our souls for the ahead!

2) CONFIDENT POSSESSION: God's people are	established in the truth!
"Therefore I intend always to remind you of these qualities and ARE ESTABLISHED in the TRUTH that you	
"THE FAITH that was <u>once for all delivered</u> to	the saints." (Jude 3b)
3) HOPE-FILLED URGENCY: Life is brief and is c	oming!
"I think it right, <u>as long as I am in this body</u> , to stir yo since I know that the <u>putting off of my body will be soo</u> made clear to me. And I will make every effort so you may be able at any time to recall these thing	<u>n</u> , as our Lord Jesus Christ that <u>after my departure</u>
Note: Peter describes his body as a disposable, and as "departure" is the word "".	d the word Peter uses translated
"For we know that if THE TENT that is our earth we have A BUILDING from God, A HOUSE not made with For <u>in THIS TENT we groan</u> , <u>longing to put on our heavenly</u>	hands, <u>eternal in the heavens</u> .
