

Sermon Title: *"In Light of That Day"* Scripture Title: 2 Peter 3:11-13 Director of Student Ministries, Matt Vohwinkel / Sunday, May 21, 2023

- 1) Knowing what awaits this world should <u>impact our desire</u> to look less like this world. (2 Peter 3:11, 2 Corinthians 5:8-10, 1 Corinthians 3:11-15)
- 2) Knowing what awaits this world should <u>incite eager longing</u> for that day to come to pass. (2 Peter 3:12)
- 3) Knowing what awaits this world should <u>intensify our focus</u> on the promise of what comes next. (2 Peter 3:13, Revelation 21, Isaiah 60:17-22; 65:17-25)

Application Questions:

If you have never given your life to Jesus, and are wanting to take that step but are unsure how, what is keeping you from reaching out to HSC this week and having that conversation?

In what ways has your knowledge of the coming day of the Lord impacted your desire to pursue a Godly life?

What are areas of sin in your life are still in need of refinement?

In light of His coming, what is the next step in pursuing holiness and Godliness in those areas?

What attitudes and feelings are incited within you as you consider the coming day of the Lord?

If they are different from the eager longing we should have as believers, why do you think that is?

Take a few moments and read the following passages: Revelation 21, Isaiah 60:17-22; 65:17-25 What do you find hopeful about these promises that await those who are in Christ?

What might regular meditation upon these future promises bring to your life in this present world?
