INTRODUCTION

Note: Thyatira was a busy, hard-working town! They were famous for their production of <u>purple</u> dye.

(Acts 16:14)

Note: Thyatira sat along an important, prosperous <u>trade</u> route, and it was known for its many business guilds or labor unions.

Note: Each one of these guilds and unions paid homage to and worshipped various <u>idols</u> and deities that they believed would bless and prosper their business dealings.

I. WHEN DISCERNMENT AND COURAGE IS LACKING

Revelation 2:18 -

THE PICTURE of Jesus is one of exalted/divine power and <u>purity</u>.

Revelation 2:19 -

THE PORTRAYAL of Thyatira is noticeably like the opposite of Ephesus.

Revelation 2:20, 24 -

THE "PROPHETESS" was deceiving many into immorality and idolatry.

(Ephesians 4:1-3)

Note: It's easy to justify sin in the name of cheap grace!

Revelation 2:21-23a -

THE PATIENCE of God was sadly <u>rejected</u> and thus judgment was coming.

(Romans 6:23 and Hebrews 4:7b)

Revelation 2:23b -

THE PURPOSE of God was to use this situation as an example to every church.

(Hebrews 6:10)

Revelation 2:24-25 -

THE PRIORITY of Jesus for His people remains the <u>same</u> and it is not complex.

Revelation 2:26-27 -

THE POSITION promised is to rule with Jesus, using the authority He's already received.

(1 Corinthians 6:2)

Revelation 2:28-29 -

THE PRIZE of "overcoming" always was and always will be <u>Jesus</u> Himself!

(Revelation 22:16)

- 5. What does Jesus promise (in verses 26-28) to those who "hold fast"?
