The City of Pergamum

- Beautiful, mountainside capital of Roman region of Asia.
- First Asian city to build a temple dedicated to the worship of a living Roman emperor.
- Site of the altar of Zeus (Altar of Pergamum).

The Letter to the Church in Pergamum

- 1. Christ's Self-Revelation as the Supreme Authority & Ruler. (v. 12)
- 2. Christ's Intimate Knowledge of His Church. (v. 13)

Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 8:3; Nahum 1:7; 2 Timothy 2:19; Hebrews 4:15-16

What did Jesus know?

- Their circumstances
- Their faith in Christ
- Their beloved martyr
- 3. Christ's Concerning Rebuke of Heresies Tolerated. (v. 14-15)

Scriptures: Numbers 22-25; 31:16; 2 Peter 2:15-16; 1 John 2:15-17, 24-25

4. Christ's Urgent Call to Repent & Wage War. (v. 16)

Scriptures: Hebrews 4:12-13; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Corinthians 10:5

- 5. Christ's eternal promises to the "one who conquers" (v. 17)
 - **Hidden Manna...**Eternal life in Christ. (John 6:32-35)
 - A White Stone...Eternal acquittal through Christ. (Romans 5:19; 8:1)
 - A New, Secret Name...Eternal delight of Christ. (Revelation 20:15; 21:27; 22:19)

- 1. Why might Pergamum have been such a difficult place to live as a Christian?
- 2. What does Christ's self-revelation communicate about Him? How does this comfort and encourage you to live in the midst of our present culture?
- 3. How does the reality of Christ's knowledge of you and your circumstances help you "hold fast" to Jesus?
- 4. What heresies were allowed to be taught in the church in Pergamum? Why is this so dangerous?
- 5. How might we need to repent and wage war within the church today? In what manner are we to wage war?
- 6. How are Christ's promises to the "one who conquers" (v. 17) especially meaningful to you?
