

Sermon Series: Revelation - Jesus Revealed Sermon Title: Prelude to the Plagues Scripture: Revelation 15 Director of Youth Ministries, Matt Vohwinkel Sunday, February 25, 2024

I. This Prelude proclaims the finality of God's wrath and the beginnings of future blessings.

(Revelation 15:1; Joel 2-3; Zephaniah 3; Zechariah 12-14)

II. This Prelude proclaims the <u>final victory</u> of God's people over their every enemy.

(Revelation 15:2, 13:15, 14:12, 12:11)

III. This Prelude proclaims Christ as the <u>final deliverer</u> of His people.

(Revelation 15:3-4, 5:9-10; Exodus 15; Psalms 77-78, 80-81; Nehemiah 9; Isaiah 63; Jeremiah 32 & 33)

IV. This Prelude proclaims both the <u>finality</u> and <u>severity</u> of the coming judgment.

(Revelation 15:5-8)

Questions to Consider:

- 1. If you knew with certainty that Christ would return tomorrow, do you know with certainty that you would spend eternity with him?
 - a. If so, on what basis?
 - b. If not, who is someone in your life, or in leadership at this church, who can help you address this eternal matter?
- 2. If you knew with certainty that Christ would return tomorrow, who are the two people in your world who would need to hear the gospel today?
 - a. What do you need to do to intentionally remind yourself to pray for them this week?
 - b. What are specific ways you can intentionally pursue conversation with them this week?
 - c. What are specific questions you can ask to pursue gospel-conversations with them this week?
