I. This Prelude proclaims the finality of God's wrath and the beginnings of future blessings.

(Revelation 15:1; Joel 2-3; Zephaniah 3; Zechariah 12-14)

II. This Prelude proclaims the final victory of God's people over their every enemy.

(Revelation 15:2, 13:15, 14:12, 12:11)

III. This Prelude proclaims Christ as the final deliverer of His people.

(Revelation 15:3-4, 5:9-10; Exodus 15; Psalms 77-78, 80-81; Nehemiah 9; Isaiah 63; Jeremiah 32 & 33)

IV. This Prelude proclaims both the finality and severity of the coming judgment.

(Revelation 15:5-8)

Questions to Consider:

1. If you knew with certainty that Christ would return tomorrow, do you know with certainty that you would spend eternity with him?
 - a. If so, on what basis?
 - b. If not, who is someone in your life, or in leadership at this church, who can help you address this eternal matter?

2. If you knew with certainty that Christ would return tomorrow, who are the two people in your world who would need to hear the gospel today?
 - a. What do you need to do to intentionally remind yourself to pray for them this week?
 - b. What are specific ways you can intentionally pursue conversation with them this week?
 - c. What are specific questions you can ask to pursue gospel-conversations with them this week?
