INTRODUCTION

Revelation 20:1-10

Note: It is MORE IMPORTANT TO _____ your fellow brothers and sisters in Christ well than it is to be RIGHT on all the details related to The Millennial Reign of Christ!

*"If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love,
I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.*

*And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge,
and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.*

*If I give away all I have, and if I deliver up my body to be burned, but have not love, I gain nothing."
(1 Corinthians 13:1-3)*

I. THE REIGN OF KING JESUS AND THE DEFEAT OF THE DRAGON

Revelation 20:1-3 -

1) Far from being victorious, Satan is a defeated enemy; his destruction is _____ coming!

2 Corinthians 4:4; Ephesians 2:2; Colossians 1:13; 1 Peter 5:8-9

Revelation 20:4-6 -

2) In spite of how things may appear, **JESUS REIGNS** and He will continue to reign! He will _____ the glory, strength, and majesty of His kingdom, and His people will reign **WITH** Him!

Jeremiah 3:16-18; Matthew 19:28-30; Matthew 24:14; Revelation 20:3

Premillennialism has that little prefix “pre” meaning that Jesus will return to earth _____ the 1,000 years, before the Millennial Reign of King Jesus.

Postmillennialism has that little prefix “post” meaning that Jesus will return to earth _____ the 1,000 years!

Amillennialism has that little prefix “a” meaning “without” or “not”. This view teaches that there will not be a literal reign of Christ on this earth for a thousand years but that Jesus is _____ (currently!) ruling and reigning from heaven and in the lives of His people, His Church.

Revelation 20:6 -

3) There is immense joy and blessing to be found in “belonging” to God, in being “holy” (set apart) to Him! Those in Christ are resurrected to eternal fellowship, access, and intimacy with God. The “second death” (eternal death, _____ from God) has no power over them!
