INTRODUCTION

Fueled for (and by!) the Glory of God!

1 Corinthians 10:31; Isaiah 40:31, 9; John 10:10-11; 2 Corinthians 4:5-6

I. OUR PLACE IN GOD'S STORY OF GRACE

1) We fight for joy!

Galatians 5:22-24 and 1 Corinthians 1:26-31

Note: We fight for joy (daily!) by treasuring Jesus, by delighting in God's free grace, and by submitting to the Spirit's good work. Please, stop listening to foolish thoughts and start preaching the <u>Gospel</u>!

2) We boast in our weakness!

2 Corinthians 12:8-10 and Hebrews 7:25

Note: God is not afraid of our weakness! God wants to use our weakness to <u>magnify</u> and showcase His power and His glory!

3) We put on our glasses!

2 Corinthians 5:16-18 and Matthew 9:37-38

Note: We glorify God by seeing people not as just fleshly, time-bound creatures but as precious, as valuable, as made in the image of God, as needing <u>Jesus</u>!
