"You <u>adulterous</u> people! Do you not know that <u>friendship with the world</u> IS <u>enmity with God</u>? Therefore whoever wishes to be <u>A FRIEND of the world</u> makes himself <u>AN ENEMY of God</u>."

(James 4:4)

1 Timothy 6:11-12; Mark 8:34; Psalm 16:1, 11

I. WHEN WORLDLINESS MEETS THE GLORY OF THE CROSS

"Do NOT <u>love the world</u> or <u>the things in the world</u>. If anyone loves the world the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world - the <u>desires</u> of the <u>flesh</u> and the <u>desires</u> of the <u>eyes</u> and <u>pride</u> of <u>life</u> - is not from the Father but is from the world. And the world IS PASSING AWAY along with its desires, but whoever does the will of God ABIDES FOREVER." (1 John 2:15-17)

A. WHAT IT ISN'T!

- 1) John is NOT encouraging us to hate this physical, natural <u>world</u> that God has created!

 (Psalm 19:1; 1 Timothy 6:17)
- 2) John is NOT lamenting the fact that we live in physical bodies in <u>modern</u> society!

 (John 17:15)
- 3) John is NOT arguing against social <u>structures</u> (blessings!) like family and government!

 (1 Peter 2:16-17)

B. WHAT IT IS!

"Do NOT <u>love the world</u> or <u>the things in the world</u>. If anyone loves the world the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world - the <u>desires</u> of the <u>flesh</u> and the <u>desires</u> of the <u>eyes</u> and <u>pride</u> of <u>life</u> - is NOT FROM <u>the Father</u> but IS FROM <u>the world</u>. And the world IS PASSING AWAY along with its desires, but <u>whoever does the will of God</u> ABIDES FOREVER." (1 John 2:15-17)

- 1) We can only have ONE supreme, ruling, preeminent FIRST <u>LOVE</u>, and it must be God! (1 John 2:15)
- 2) Worldliness is defined as those beliefs, temptations, philosophies that are <u>opposed</u> to God. (1 John 2:16; Proverbs 16:25; Psalm 119:105; 2 Corinthians 10:3-5)

C. THE "HEART" OF THE MATTER!

- Fleshly cravings, lust, sinful desires, boatful arrogance are ALL <u>heart</u> issues!
 (1 John 2:17)
- 2) Those who chase after worldliness end up impoverished, with <u>NOTHING</u> of lasting value! (1 John 2:17)
- 3) The real issue is not so much about fighting against worldliness but cultivating <u>love</u> for Christ!

 (Galatians 6:14)
