• Why was the worship of Ba'al and the Ashteroth so heinous to God?

I. God's love fuels His anger to preserve a faithful people. (v. 8; 2:20)

II. God sovereignly fulfills His good purposes, even through human evil. (v. 9)

III. God's lovingkindness is magnified by the unworthiness of His people. (v. 10-11)

IV. God purposes often unfold through the unlikely and the unsettling. (v. 12-26)

• What people and circumstances are surprising or unsettling in v. 12-26?

V. God often uses one person's **bold faith** to strengthen many. (v. 27-31)

Conclusion: God hears the cry of His people and acts in surprising ways to deliver them, foreshadowing the ultimate deliverance through Jesus Christ.
