Text: Judges 6



INTRODUCTION

"As a father shows compassion to his children, so the Lord shows compassion to those who fear Him. For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust." (Psalm 103:13-14)

I. GRACE THAT HURTS AND HEALS

A. God's "Inappropriate" Answer (verses 1-10)

Note: Instead of sending a protector, God sends a prophet to deliver a timely message that would bring much needed <u>spiritual</u> insight, conviction, and understanding!

(Romans 2:4; Romans 5:8-9)

B. God's Insecure Warrior (verses 11-24)

1) God's calling is God's <u>enablement</u>. God is foreshadowing what Gideon will become because of His work and His grace in his life!

(1 Corinthians 15:10)

2) God loves to choose, to use, to strengthen those who are regarded as weak, as "less than", and as insignificant because this <u>magnifies</u> God's power and His wisdom!

(2 Corinthians 12:9b-10)

3) God promises Gideon the best thing and the only thing that really matters, Himself.

(Hebrews 13:5)

4) There's nothing more comforting or <u>overwhelming</u> than God's presence!

(Isaiah 57:15)

C. God's Irritating (and Inconvenient!) Command (verses 25-32)

Note: Before Gideon could declare "war" on Midian, he needed to declare "war" on Baal!

(Matthew 6:24)

D. God's Imminent Victory (verses 33-35)

Note: Today, God continues to use His people (filled with HIs Spirit!) to advance His Kingdom, by advancing His <u>Gospel</u>, which transforms hearts and minds!

(1 John 5:4-5)

E. God's Incredible (and Irrefutable!) Assurance (verses 36-40)

Note: We should see our God as so kind, understanding, and sympathetic; He is <u>eager</u> to bring comfort and assurance to His people!

(Hebrews 4:15-16)

Questions for Further Study, Reflection, and Application...

- 1. Why did God first send a prophet to His people when they cried out for help and deliverance?
- 2. What did the prophet say? Why did he emphasize God's faithfulness and goodness?
- 3. How did God help and encourage Gideon throughout their conversation in verses 11-24? What did God promise to him?
- 4. Why did God command Gideon to tear down Baal's altar? Is there any application for us?
- 5. What did God give to Gideon through the wet/dry fleece situation? What should we learn from this?
