Main Point #1 - The danger from <u>within</u> is always more serious and more destructive than the danger from without!

Main Point #2 - Even when we cannot see God's hand, plan, or purpose, He is working!

A. The Problem of Leadership

Judges 9:1-6 -

1) Instead of proud, calloused, murderous self-promotion, God calls us to sacrificial love!

John 10:10-11 and John 10:27-28

Judges 9:7-21 -

2) When it comes to leadership, <u>character</u> is paramount! Character is more important than natural ability, personality, or raw talent!

Matthew 20:25-28 and 1 Peter 5:5

B. The Providence of the Lord

Judges 9:22-25 -

1) God is not ignorant, lazy, or incompetent when it comes to matters of justice and righteousness. God is wise, zealous, persistent, and unchanging in His <u>holiness</u>.

Romans 6:23

Judges 9:26-57 -

2) "Bramble Kings" will come and go; their destruction often comes unexpectedly, but our God knows how to both rescue and preserve His people, now and <u>forevermore!</u>
