## Philippians 2:1-5

In Summary: Paul is going to forcefully and convincingly argue for daily, ongoing, life-changing pervasive UNITY & HUMILITY that is directly linked to, powered by, and grounded in!
I. UNITY & HUMILITY: THE MOST UNNATURAL WAY TO LIVE
"So IF there is any ENCOURAGEMENT <u>in Christ</u> , any COMFORT <u>from love</u> , any PARTICIPATION in <u>the Spirit</u> , any AFFECTION and SYMPATHY" (Philippians 2:1)
(Romans 8:38-39; 1 Corinthians 6:19; John 15:26; Romans 5:5)
Note: Paul is going to base his plea for unity and humility upon what God has
A. Cultivate Unity
" <u>complete my joy</u> BY being of the <u>same mind</u> , having the <u>same love</u> , being in <u>full accord</u> and of <u>one mind</u> ." (Philippians 2:2)
While cultivating unity is not easy, it can/should produce ever-expanding!
2) Unity is an job!
(John 17:20-23)

#### B. Walk in Humility

# "DO NOTHING from <u>selfish ambition</u> or <u>conceit</u>, but IN HUMILITY count others <u>more significant</u> than <u>yourselves</u>. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also <u>to the interests of others</u>." (Philippians 2:3-4)

There is an absolute command to ENTIRELY	selfish ambition and conceit!
Note: Selfish ambition and conceit looks at life and "What about ME? How can you serve ME? How can y promote ME? How can I YOU for MY desires, for M	you glorify ME? How can you
