#### INTRODUCTION

"Finally, my brothers, rejoice in the Lord. To write the same things to you is no trouble to me and is safe for you." (Philippians 3:1)

"Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit."

(Psalm 51:12)

# Philippians 3:7-11

Note: These verses clearly express THE JOY of forsaking self to KNOW JESUS!

Note: Paul longs for his readers to know and to experience what he has known and experienced: the life, the wisdom, the power, the forgiveness, the righteousness, the fellowship, the certain hope, and the joy of Jesus.

(John 10:14-15; John 17:3; 1 John 5:20-21)

#### I. THE SURPASSING WORTH OF KNOWING CHRIST JESUS MY LORD

Philippians 3:8b-9 -

1) The righteousness of Jesus is given (imputed) to us BY <u>FAITH</u> (never by works!).

What does Paul mean by "righteousness"? What does Paul mean by "faith"?

Note: The very righteousness that God delights in and requires, He <u>provides</u> for us in Christ!

(Romans 3:23; Romans 3:10-12; 2 Corinthians 5:21)

Note: Faith is believing, <u>trusting</u>, and treasuring Jesus. And faith will be seen, it will be evidenced, it will "bear the fruit" of love, worship, joy, thanksgiving, and obedience to God!

### Philippians 3:10a -

2) We can have, know, and experience Jesus' power and victory over sin and death!

"But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, who will transform our lowly body to be like His glorious body, by the power that enables Him even to subject all things to Himself." (Philippians 3:20-21)

### Philippians 3:10b -

3) Jesus' character, Jesus' love for His Father, Jesus' love for others, Jesus' submission to the will of God, Jesus' confidence in the Father's plan is being <u>FORMED</u> IN US.

"I have said these things to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world." (John 16:33)

(John 19:30; Luke 23:46; Luke 23:34)

## Philippians 3:11 -

4) Jesus loves, leads, resurrects, and safely brings His people <u>HOME</u>, into His presence, into a place of unending life, glory, and joy in Him!

- 1. What does Paul mean by the word "know"? Is he referring to knowing facts or something more?
- 2. Why do we, as proud, sinful humans, struggle to accept and believe salvation by grace?
- 3. What is the righteousness that Jesus gives? How do we receive it?
- 4. What sufferings do we share with Christ? What is God's purpose for these sufferings?
- 5. How has God opened your eyes to see your need for Jesus and His righteousness? When did this happen? What were the circumstances?
